AEP Foundation Donates To PHCC Foundation

The American Electric Power [AEP] Foundation, a charitable organization which aims to improve lives through education, awarded Patrick Henry Community College a grant for nearly two-hundred thousand dollars.

With the grant, the college established the AEP Foundation Industry 4.0 Alliance. The Alliance is made up of industry leaders and community partners who support the growth and expansion of Industry 4.0 training at PHCC. The Alliance, which is headlined by the AEP Foundation, also includes NC3 and Festo – industry leaders in advanced manufacturing – and community partners such as The Harvest Foundation. The college anticipates that more partners

will be joining the newly formed alliance soon.



The first objective for the Alliance was to help PHCC launch Industry 4.0 level two training to prepare graduates to work with cloud computing and cyber-physical technologies. The grant money from the AEP Foundation and donations from other members of the Alliance will cover some of the startup costs and equipment purchases PHCC will need to begin offering Industry 4.0 level two certification training. The college has been offering the Industry 4.0 level one certification since August 2018.

The concept for Industry 4.0 training was developed just last year by NC3 in partnership with Festo and leaders in other

advanced manufacturing industries. Training for this emerging career field is so new that PHCC is one of only two other colleges in the nation to offer all level 1 certifications. Presently, PHCC is the only training facility in America that now offers the Industry 4.0 level 2 and level 3 certifications.

"Thanks to the support of our AEP Foundation Industry 4.0 Alliance partners, PHCC is able to rapidly respond to industry innovation. You cannot get more up-to-date and relevant than this level of training." says PHCC instructor Daniel Edwards. "Being on the cutting edge of industry developments means our students know how to work with, run, and troubleshoot some of the most advanced equipment in the industry. They are setting themselves apart in a major way – putting on their resume exactly the skills that local employers are looking for."

For the students, earning an Industry 4.0 level 2 or 3 certification could mean more job offers to higher paying jobs and faster career advancement. Locally, employers like Mehler Engineered Products, Eastman, Georgia Pacific, and Hanesbrands are already seeking employees who have the level 2 skills. Locally, positions that require level 2 or 3 certifications typically pay more than \$40,000 a year.

"Getting certified in Industry 4.0 level 1 has already proven highly beneficial to our students," says Edwards. "Now, we are literally taking it to a whole new level. The jobs they'll be able to get and the pay they can make will increase with each level we can offer. What we're doing thanks to the AEP Foundation Industry 4.0 Alliance will have an incredible impact in our students' lives – opening doors to the middle class."

FOUNDATION HIGHLIGHTS

- > The foundation accounted for 18% of the college's operating budget. A total of \$2,687,013 was provided, with \$718,864 awarded in scholarships. Other major areas funded by the foundation include faculty and staff positions, technology advancement, equipment, Student Art Show awards, and a number of special college projects.

Edwards Named Teaching Faculty Of The Year

Every year, Patrick Henry Community College (PHCC) recognizes one outstanding instructor as the Teaching Faculty Member of the Year. The chosen instructor is recognized for making a tremendous impact on the campus and in students' lives and receives a \$2000 cash prize and a

significant professional development stipend from the Patrick Henry Community College Foundation.

During the college's commencement ceremony, this year's award was presented to Daniel Edwards the college's Instructor of Industrial Electronics Technology.

Edwards was instrumental in implementing the Mechatronics program at PHCC in 2013. Since the program's inception, it has grown explosively – issuing over 300 national certifications. For six years in a row, Edward's program has maintained a 100% passing rate. Every student that has taken the national industry certification exam has passed.

This past year, Edwards was influential in coordinating the college's partnership with the National Coalition of

Certification Centers [NC3] and Festo. These partnerships have provided his students with numerous opportunities to gain skills and credentials that are in high demand by local employers. Because of the caliber of the program that Edwards has built, a multitude of employers from around the region are actively seeking to recruit his graduates.

"Daniel Edwards exemplifies everything that is good about PHCC's faculty," says Colin Ferguson Dean of Science Technology Engineering, Math – Health and Applied Programs. "He is there for his

students. His graduates are successful. He is fully dedicated to student success. He deserves to be recognized."

Michelle Zollars, an Associate Professor of Developmental English, was recognized as PHCC Distinguished Faculty of 2019 and received \$750 from the PHCC Foundation for her commitment to student success.

Zollars' role at the college extends well beyond the classroom. From training adjunct faculty members to redesigning policies to increase student engagement, she consistently goes above and beyond to ensure her students and her fellow instructors have everything they need to make PHCC an excellent learning environment.

Each year the PHCC Foundation selects deserving students to receive full tuition and textbooks for up to two academic years. The Commonwealth Legacy Scholarships are administered by the PHCC Foundation. They are available to first-time college students enrolled full-time at PHCC. Students are selected by a scholarship committee and must maintain at least a 2.0 GPA. Recipients also must demonstrate potential for public service and a commitment to developing civic leadership.

Martha Lou Henry Scholarship

Every nurse has the opportunity to change lives for the better. It would not be possible to estimate the number of lives Martha Lou Henry touched over her lifetime. For over four decades, she served as a nurse at Children's Medical Center in Martinsville, VA. After she passed away in 2018, she set into place a legacy that will continue to impact the community and change lives for the better for many years to come.

To benefit the area's future nurses, Henry left over \$50,000 to Patrick Henry Community College. The donation will be used to create the Martha Lou Henry Endowed Nursing Scholarship which will be awarded yearly to eligible nursing students. Recipients will be able to use the scholarship for tuition, textbooks, testing fees, uniforms, or supplies. Henry's donation also includes a \$10,000 allowance for immediate student needs within the nursing program.

"What a wonderful gift for our students to receive from a nurse who has served the community for many years," says Tiffani Underwood, Executive Director of the PHCC Foundation. "By passing on her nursing legacy in this

way, Martha is providing a wonderful opportunity for our students - opening doors for them to pursue bright futures."
